What is TeenPact?

TeenPact Leadership Schools is a nonprofit ministry that offers State Classes around the country to educate students in civics from a biblical perspective. We offer a Four Day Class for students ages 13 - 19, as well as a One Day Class for students ages 8 - 12.

Where is the State Class held?

The 2024 State Class will be held at First Baptist Church of Denver, near the capitol. TeenPact values hands-on learning, so we want our students to experience the accessibility of their state leaders as they learn how the government works.

When is the State Class?

- ★ **Four Day Class (ages 13 - 19):** February 19 - 22, 2024
 - **Monday:** 1:00 - 5:00 p.m.,
 - **Tuesday-Thursday:** 8:45 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.
 - **Evening Sessions:** Monday - Wednesday, after class until 8:00 p.m.
- ★ **Political Communication Workshop (ages 13-19):** February 23, 2024, 10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.
- ★ **One Day Class (ages 8-12):** February 23, 2024, 10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

Is there homework for TeenPact?

Yes. We have created homework for the students to complete prior to the class to help ensure the students come to the class with the same basic knowledge to enhance their learning during the event. These assignments can be found at teenpact.com/homework.

Is there a dress code for TeenPact?

Yes. We ask that students follow a specific professional attire dress code for the class, which we call, Capitol Attire. Please review the dress code prior to arrival by visiting teenpact.com/dresscode.

***Note:** If Four Day Students choose to attend Evening Sessions throughout the week, attire will be TeenPact casual. Please reference our requirements for casual attire at the link above if you plan to join us at Evening Sessions.*

Can I drop my student off at the class?

- ★ **Four Day Class:** If your student is attending the Four Day Class, you are welcome to drop your student off for the class each day, though we love to have parents join us to see what your student is learning.
- ★ **Political Communication Workshop:** Similarly to the Four Day Class, parents of students attending the workshop are not required to stay for the day, but are always welcome!
- ★ **One Day Class:** Parents of One Day Students are required to stay with their student throughout the entirety of the class. If you are unable to join, we ask that you find another adult to join your student as a chaperone for the class.

How much does TeenPact cost?

- ★ **Four Day Class:** \$320.00 First Time Students or \$290.00 Alumni Students
- ★ **Political Communication Workshop:** \$50.00 with Four Day Class or \$60 for workshop only
- ★ **One Day Class:** \$40.00 for all One Day Students

Are discounts available for the class?

TeenPact offers several discounts for each class:

- ★ **Early Bird Discount:** Receive \$15 off the Four Day Class or \$5 off the One Day Class if you register prior to December 21.
- ★ **Refer-a-Friend Discount:** Have friends who want to join us? You and your friend can each save \$10 off your registration for each friend you recruit, up to 10 students you recruit, to save you up to \$100! More information can be found at teenpact.com/refer.
- ★ **Presidential Discount:** The presidential discount is for families with various eligibility. If any of the following apply to you, just enter the discount code **PRESIDENT** at checkout to save \$15 off your Four Day tuition.

 - Attended a 2023 two-week Summit Ministries Student Conference
 - Are currently a 2023 officer for a Generation Joshua Club
 - Were an elected official at a 2023 State Class

 - Are a family currently serving in full-time ministry

Are meals provided at the class?

Lunch for students is included in the cost of the Four Day Class and Political Communication Workshop. Lunch for One Day Students and families is available to purchase for \$8 per person, which can be purchased online at the time of registration.

Evening Session dinners are available for Four Day Students and families for \$30 per person for the week, which can be purchased online at time of registration.
