

WHAT TO EXPECT

Each class includes the following:

- Bible memory verse or daily activity routine in Spanish
- Interactive storytelling
- Vocabulary review activities/games
- Conversation practice

Monthly Vocab Themes & Conversation Topics:

August – Welcome! Similar words in Spanish (cognates); colors/shapes; conversation starters

September – School supplies/subjects; days of week; numbers; alphabet sounds

October – Monarch butterfly fall migration to Mexico; maps/directions; 12 Phrases in Spanish

November – “Gracias por...” (Thank you for...); family/pets; transportation

December – “Noche de Paz” (Silent Night), winter sports/travel

January – Calendar months/seasonal activities; opposites; 10 questions

February – Likes/dislikes, personal characteristics/feelings

March – Numbers/practical uses (measuring, sharing calendar dates, telling time, solving simple math equations)

April/May – favorite foods; shopping; fiesta fun and awards

Gouin Series:

Acting out daily routines in English and then switching the words to Spanish (Gouin Series) helps students use Spanish in context. Series are chosen for their age appropriateness in terms of content and length.

Advanced Students:

Older or more advanced students will also receive an introduction to verb conjugation as well as enjoy more reading and writing activities.
